

Pillow Talk Step 2

In this step we will complete the 28 of each Log Cabin. If you are doing a value reversal, watch for notes in the cutting instructions that indicate what fabric to substitute (VR Fabric #...).

Fabric #1: (VR Fabric #5)

Cut two strips 4 ½" x wof. Set aside.

Cut two strips 6 ½" x wof. Set aside.

Cut two strips 4 ½" x wof. Cut these strips into 56 - 1 ½" x 4 ½" rectangles.

Cut two strips 6 ½" x wof. Cut these strips into 56 - 1 ½" x 6 ½" rectangles.

Fabric #2 & #3: (VR Fabric #4)

Cut two strips EACH 1 ½" x wof. Set aside.

Fabric #4: (VR Fabric #2)

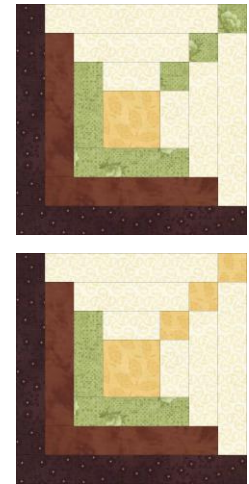
Cut two strips 5 ½" x wof. Cut these strips into 56 - 1 ½" x 5 ½" rectangles.

Cut two strips 6 ½" x wof. Cut these strips into 56 - 1 ½" x 6 ½" rectangles.

Fabric #5: (VR Fabric #1)

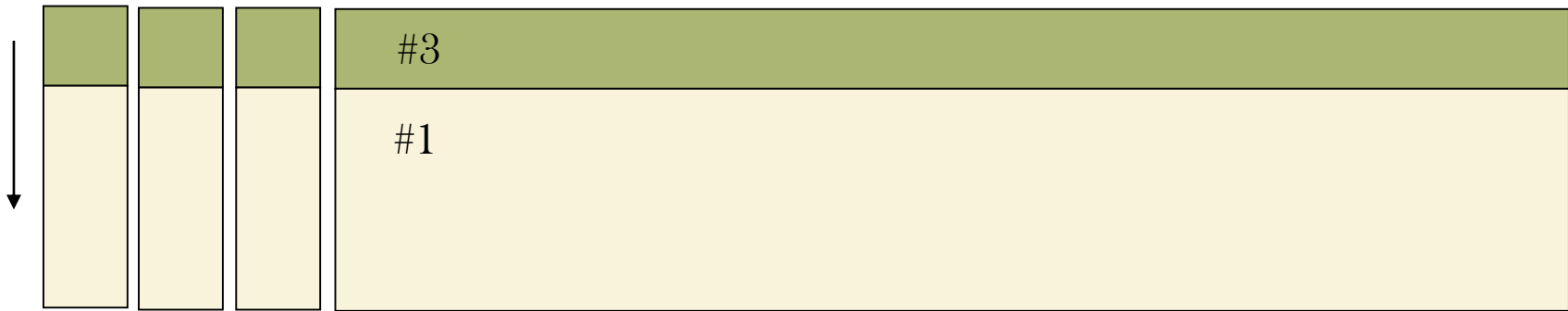
Cut two strips 7 ½" x wof. Cut these strips into 56 - 1 ½" x 7 ½" rectangles.

Cut two strips 8 ½" x wof. Cut these strips into 56 - 1 ½" x 8 ½" rectangles.

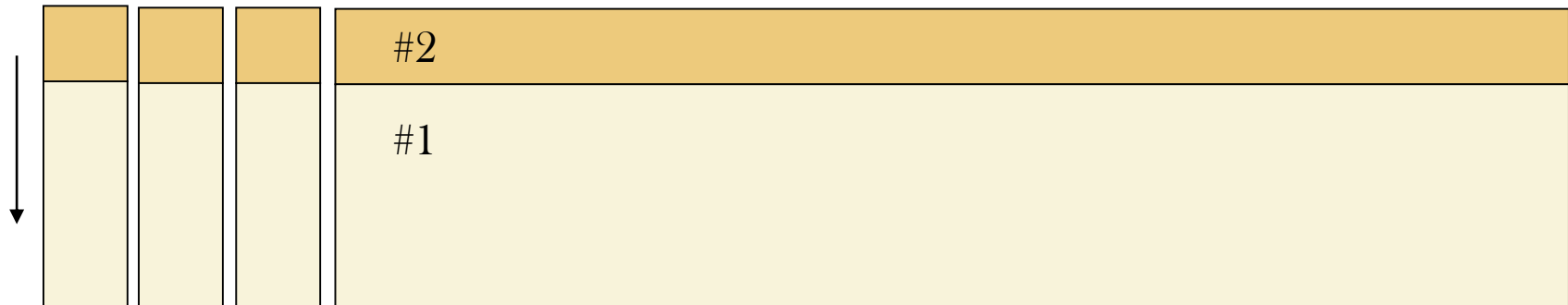


Pillow Talk Step 2

Gather one Fabric #1 - 4 ½" strip and one Fabric #3 - 1 ½" strip.
Stitch them together along the length. Press the seam toward Fabric #1.
Cut into 28 - 1 ½" x 5 ½" segments.

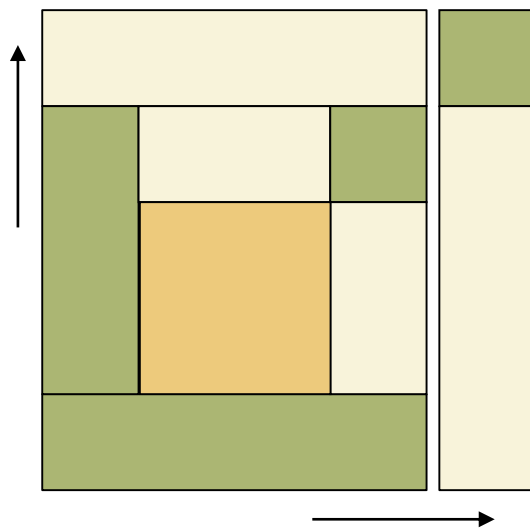


Repeat this using the remaining Fabric #1 - 4 ½" strip and the Fabric #2 - 1 ½" strip.
Press the seam toward Fabric #1. Cut into 28 - 1 ½" x 5 ½" segments.

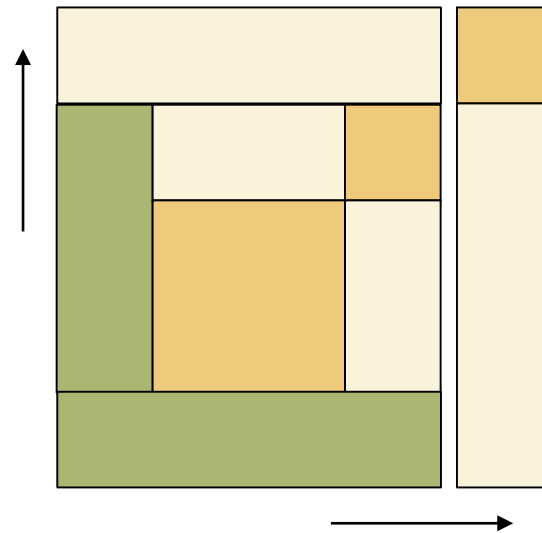


Pillow Talk Step 2

Gather the 56 Fabric #1, $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles. Stitch them to the top of the units completed in Step 1 in the orientation shown. Press the seam toward the $4\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle. Then stitch the $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $5\frac{1}{2}$ " units completed on the previous page, to the right side of the unit in the orientation shown. Press the seam toward the $5\frac{1}{2}$ " unit. Stitch the units together as shown. Press the seams in the direction shown. Make 28 each.



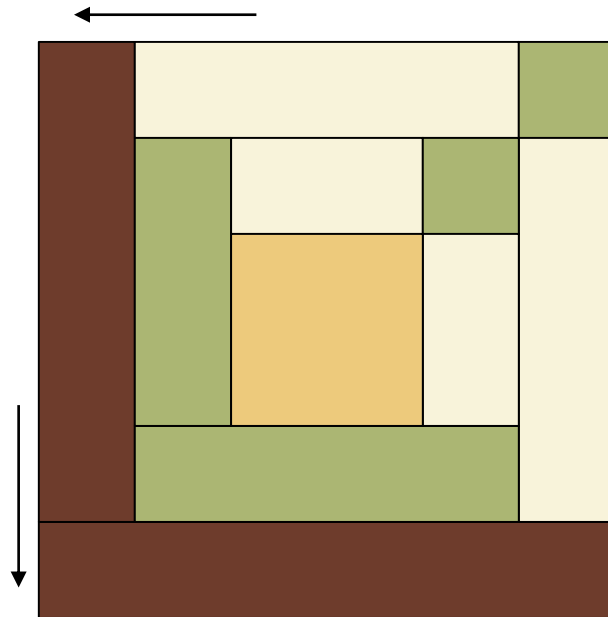

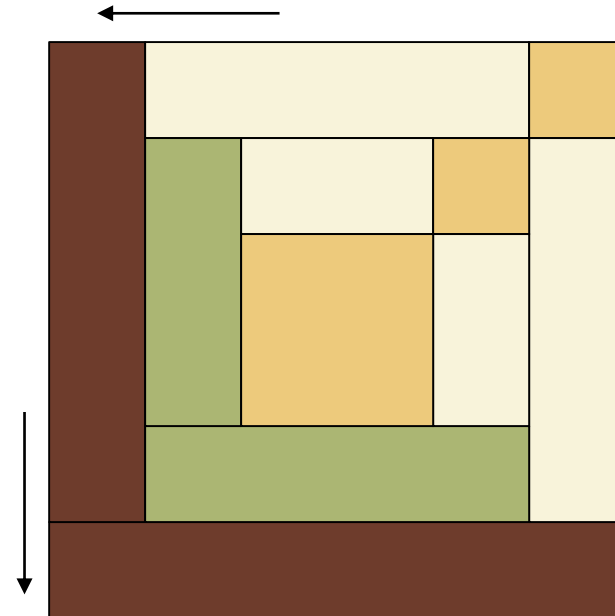

Pillow Talk Step 2

Gather the 56 Fabric #4, 1 ½" x 5 ½" rectangles & 6 ½" rectangles. Stitch a 5 ½" rectangle to the left side of the units completed on the previous page in the orientation shown. Press the seam toward the 5 ½" rectangle. Then stitch the 1 ½" x 6 ½" rectangle to the bottom of the unit in the orientation shown. Press the seam toward the 6 ½" rectangle. Make 28 each.



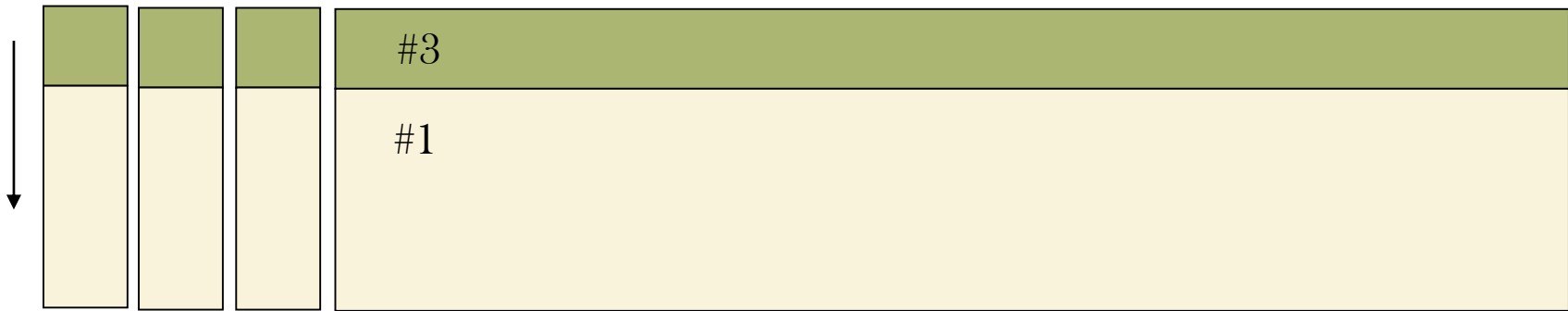

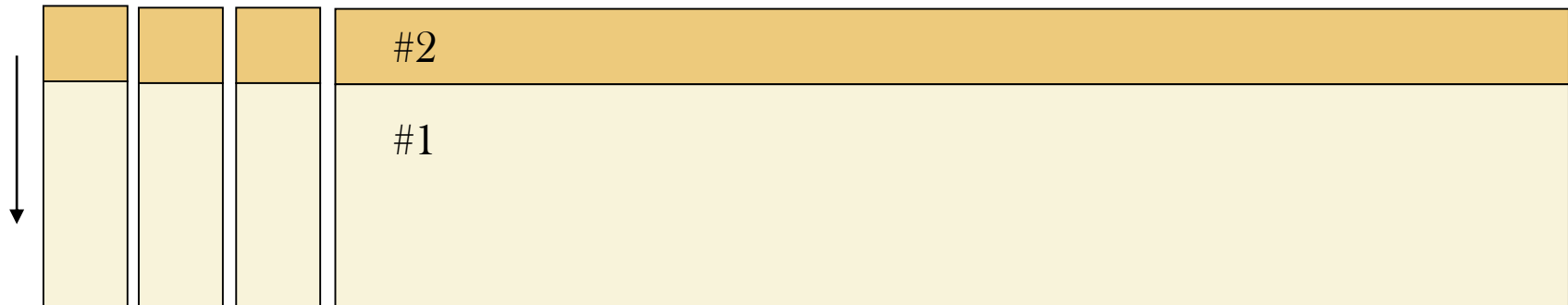

Pillow Talk Step 2

Gather one Fabric #1 - 6 ½" strip and one Fabric #3 - 1 ½" strip.
Stitch them together along the length. Press the seam toward Fabric #1.
Cut into 28 - 1 ½" x 7 ½" segments.



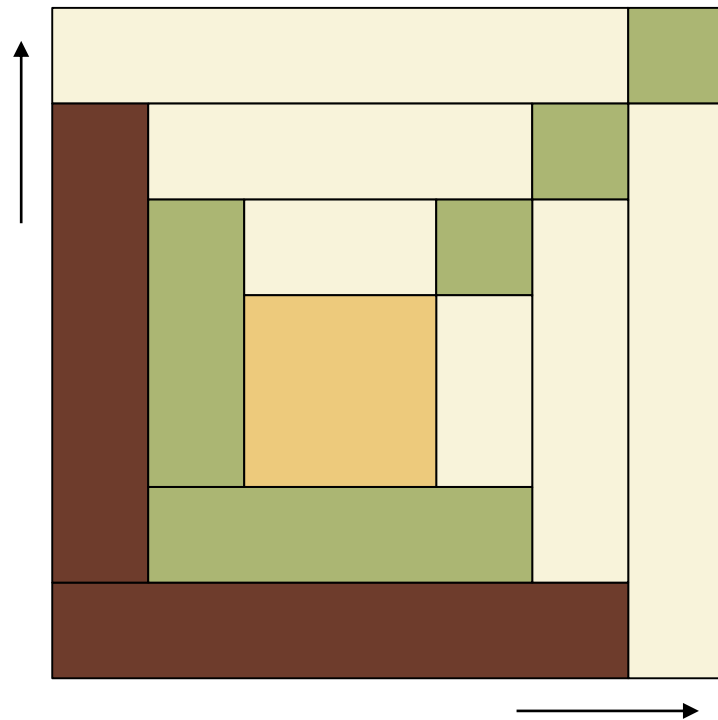
Repeat this using the remaining Fabric #1 - 6 ½" strip and the Fabric #2 - 1 ½" strip.
Press the seam toward Fabric #1. Cut into 28 - 1 ½" x 7 ½" segments.



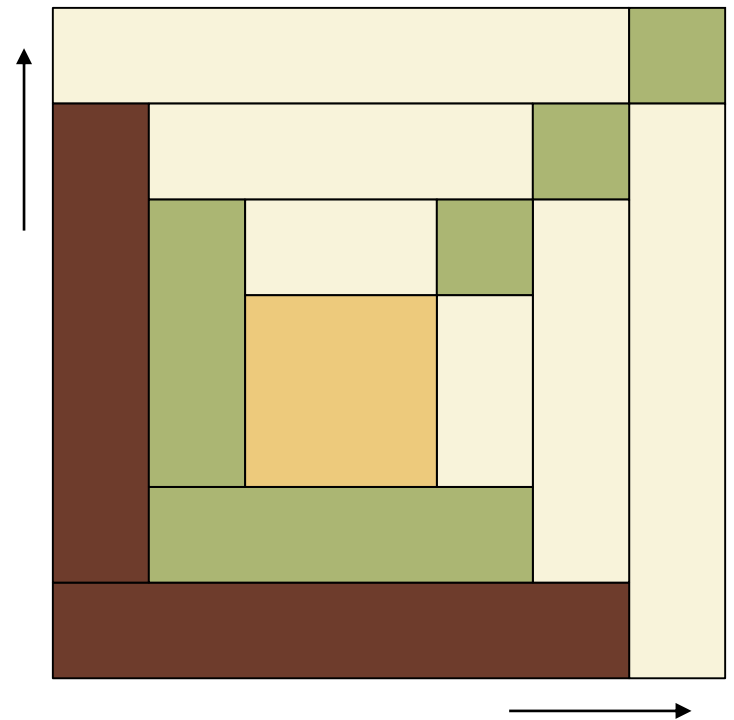
Pillow Talk Step 2

Gather the 56 Fabric #1, 1 ½" x 6 ½" rectangles. Stitch them to the top of the units you've just completed in the orientation shown. Press the seam toward the 6 ½" rectangle. Then stitch the 1 ½" x 7 ½" units completed on the previous page, to the right side of the unit in the orientation shown. Press the seam toward the 7 ½" unit.

Stitch the units together as shown. Press the seams in the direction shown. Make 28 each.



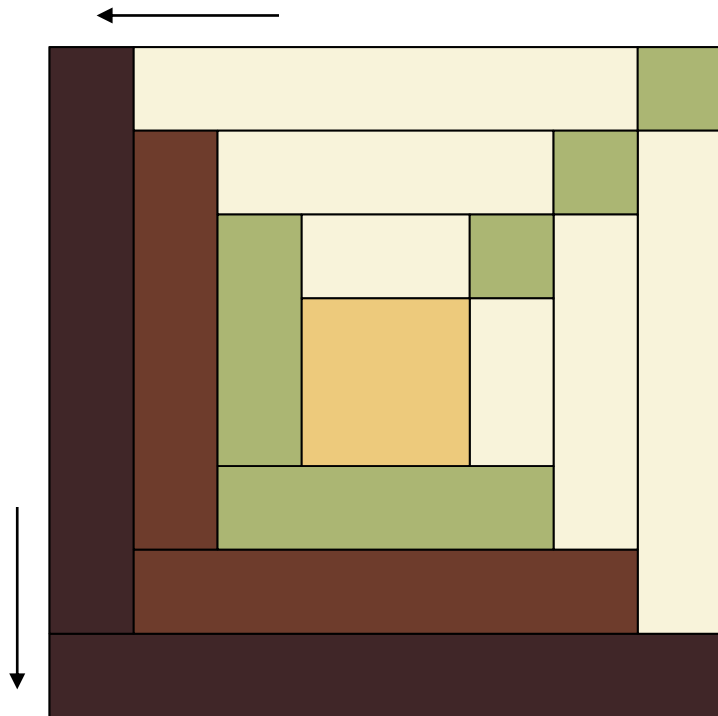

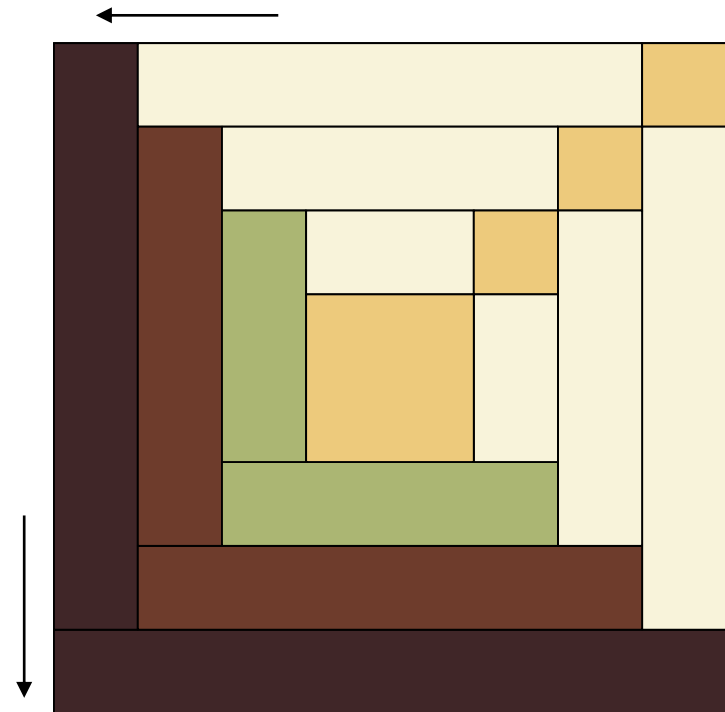

Pillow Talk Step 2

Gather the 56 Fabric #5, 1 ½" x 7 ½" rectangles & 8 ½" rectangles. Stitch a 7 ½" rectangle to the left side of the units completed on the previous page in the orientation shown. Press the seam toward the 7 ½" rectangle. Then stitch the 1 ½" x 8 ½" rectangle to the bottom of the unit in the orientation shown. Press the seam toward the 8 ½" rectangle. Make 28 each.
